UniPhi (Aus) Pty Ltd, referred to as UniPhi, a Sydney-based technology company,

When Power BI was released by Microsoft in July 2015, UniPhi's founder and CEO Mark Heath saw it as the tool that would unlock the power of the data stored in UniPhi's core web application. The years before this release UniPhi had been hunting for ways to provide flexibility in methods of presenting data captured in its software. This included the development of its template engine, custom SQL Reporting Services Reports and our 2009 release of a "Data Warehouse in a Box" feature. It's no wonder UniPhi jumped at the chance of integrating the functionality of Power BI into its ecosystem; producing "stand-alone" dashboards, charts and reporting capabilities customised to suit client specific requirements.

It was in August 2021 Deloitte recognised this quality in the PDS (Aust) Group and a merge of two high performance businesses was created. The Financial Review, Street Talk article published 16 August 2021 sums it up perfectly with the following quote from the Deloitte Australia CEO Adam Powick;

It was a "really interesting, innovative" move for Deloitte to try and gain greater share of Australia's property development and infrastructure spend by adding this service offering of project and development management to construction companies for the first time.

"With the construction sector, and the infrastructure agenda being such an important driver behind Australia's COVID-19 recovery, there is significant demand for advisory and project management services"

Deloitte also posted their own press release the same day, where CEO Andrew Fortey was quoted saying:

 - use these reports to make better and informed decisions
 - provide clear priorities to consultants on work allocation
- Efficiency
 - remove duplication - enter it once use many is the UniPhi mantra and our integration with MS Outlook, accounting systems, document management and other platforms enable this to be a reality
 - enhanced timesheet screens enabled Deloittes PDS Group to enter time the way they were use to reducing change management

As the Deloitte PDS Group advance, the ongoing outcomes of the UniPhi platform is the flexibility to adapt and grow with them providing end to end workflows that remove double handling of information, compilation of reports for management and the actual attainment of forward looking resource plans. Many companies are unable to achieve this goal due to the consistent and concerted effort required in achieving it. The time savings realised by the simpler invoicing and automated reporting can be re-allocated to the more important forward looking estimates of project performance and work allocation.
